Indian Numismatic, Historical and Cultural Research Foundation (INHCRF) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Deccan College Post-Graduate Research Institute (DCPRI), Deemed University, Pune with a view to strengthen, formalise, and cement the already existing relations between two institutions for the promotion of studies and research in the fields of archaeology, numismatics etc.

Now, both the Institutions will be able to officially collaborate in undertaking projects on prehistory, protohistory, rock art, historical archaeology, ethno-archaeology, art, architecture, iconography, numismatics, epigraphy etc. as well as in conducting joint conferences, seminars and workshops.

The faculty and students of both the institutions will now be able to use each other's databases and library for studies and research. INHCRF has also agreed to organize special workshops and training courses on numismatics for the students of DCPRI and DCPRI has agreed to make provision for co-opting INHCRF faculty as co-guides for the students carrying out Post-Graduate dissertations and Ph.D. thesis.

Both the institutions have also agreed to share their expertise, antiquities etc., for exhibitions, exchange their publications and collaborate on outreach programmes.
